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NEW SIDEWALK INSTALLATION REBATE FORM GUIDELINES

The goal of the City of Waukeee's Sidewalk Improvement Rebate Program is to assist individual property owners, in the installation of new public sidewalk abutting their properties to protect the general public and to improve the appearance of the neighborhood. The Rebate Program is for properties, in the current year's sidewalk improvement program, that were not required to have sidewalk installed during development.

The rebates are for the following situations:

- One street frontage shall result in a 50% rebate of the City Quotation cost of 4 foot wide P.C.C sidewalk*
- Two or more street frontage shall result in a 100% rebate of the City Quotation costs for the shortest street frontage of 4 foot wide P.C.C. sidewalk.*

*If Property Owner chooses to perform his/her own installation, meeting all City requirements and standards, the rebate will be calculated using the **lowest** costs, not to exceed the City Quotation pricing and will be at the percentages listed above.

Selecting and securing a contractor is the responsibility of the property owner.

Step 1: Complete a Sidewalk Improvement Program Permit Application. Forms maybe obtained by visiting the following locations: www.waukeee.org, Waukeee City Hall, or Waukeee Public Works. There is no charge for this permit.

Step 2: The sidewalk contractor or property owner will need to contact the Public Works Office at 515.987.4363, to schedule a sidewalk installation inspection prior to pouring concrete.

Step 3: Upon the completion of the installation of the sidewalk and when all forms and construction debris has been removed then a final sidewalk inspection needs to take place. To schedule an inspection please contact Public Works. Installation of new sidewalk must be complete by September 15th to be eligible.

Step 4: Once you have received an approved final inspection, complete and submit your application for a rebate to City Hall no later than **November 1, 2011**. The rebates are subject to approval by the Waukeee City Council.
