This is not a planned regular or special meeting of the Waukee City Council. It is, however, a meeting where three or more council members may be present and where policy may be discussed. If such a meeting shall take place, "the nature of the good cause justifying the departure from the normal requirements (of 24 hour notice by posting) shall be stated in the minutes."
