Waukee Celebrates Natural Gas Utility Workers' Day on March 18

The City of Waukee will observe the national Gas Utility Workers' Day on March 18, 2023. This day is celebrated across the country as a way to give recognition to the employees of natural gas utilities and their dedication to supplying reliable, safe, affordable energy to homes. The City of Waukee owns and operates the City of Waukee Gas Utility which serves 8,047 accounts with approximately 144 miles of gas main.



This day was chosen in honor of the London, Texas school explosion on March 18, 1937, that led to the widespread odorization of natural gas and an increased emphasis on safety. Safety is a vital aspect to natural gas distribution, and gas employees endeavor to make natural gas delivery as safe as possible.
