

## DOG PARK PASSES

All dogs entering the Trailside Dog Park must have a valid annual pass tag attached to their collars, made visible at all times.

**Waukee residents** will need to license all dogs with the City of Waukee prior to applying for Trailside Dog Park passes. Annual pet licenses can be purchased 24 hours a day at PetData.com. For questions, call 1-855-585-8157 on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

**Non-residents** will need to purchase an annual or one-day, non-resident park pass in order to enter the park; City of Waukee pet licenses are not required.

Verification of rabies and distemper/parvo vaccines is required when purchasing park passes. Upload or bring a copy of your veterinarian records.



## ABOUT TRAILSIDE

The four-acre Trailside Dog Park is located just east of Alice's Road in Waukee, directly south of the popular Heart of the Warrior Trail. The park includes public restrooms, 21 parking stalls, separated large/small dog areas, a drinking fountain, dog waste stations, a shade structure, concrete walking paths, benches and open greenspaces. It also features a trail connection and bicycle racks. In addition to visitors with dogs, general trail users can also utilize the public restrooms and drinking fountain at the park.

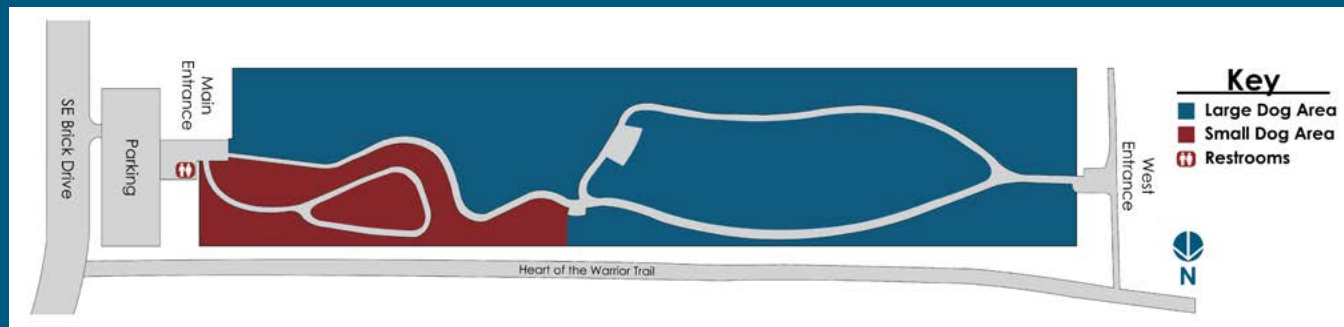

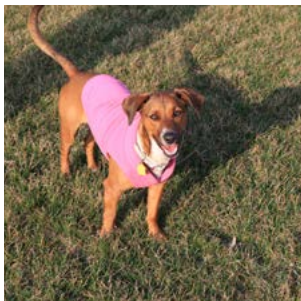

**Please assist us in keeping the park safe and enjoyable for all visitors by:**

- Purchasing an annual permit or daily pass for each dog. The funds help to offset the cost of operating Trailside Dog Park. Permits also help to ensure that dogs have been vaccinated.
- Cleaning up after your dog(s) and using the provided waste bags and containers.
- Abiding by the rules regarding children. Although it may sound like fun, dog parks are not great play areas for small children.
- Following all of the rules in this brochure and those posted at Trailside Dog Park.

## PARK RULES

1. Use of Trailside Dog Park is at the owner/handler's own risk. Pass holders and their guests agree to hold the City of Waukee harmless for any injury or damages to person or property while using the park.
2. All dogs who enter must have a valid annual pass attached to their collars, made visible at all times, or a valid daily pass.
3. Hours of Trailside Dog Park are 7 a.m. to sunset (7 p.m. during the winter).
4. Passes will not be issued to puppies younger than 16 weeks old.
5. Dogs with known histories of aggression, fighting or biting are not allowed in the park. Any dog exhibiting aggressive or unruly behavior is required to be removed by the handler immediately. Dog owners will be held liable for their dog's actions. If your dog gets into an altercation please exchange contact information with the other dog owner(s). Any dog exhibiting aggressive tendencies is subject to pass revocation.
6. Dog handlers must be at least 16 years old. Children/teenagers ages 10-15 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Children under the age of 10 are not allowed inside Trailside Dog Park.
7. There is a maximum of two dogs allowed per handler.
8. No wheeled or motorized vehicles are allowed in the dog park unless used for a disability.
9. Dogs must enter and exit the park on a leash. Once inside the fenced park, handlers may unleash their dog. Dog handlers are responsible for carrying a leash for each dog within the park while staying within eyesight and voice control of their dog(s) at all times. Dogs cannot be left unattended at any time.
10. All owners/handlers must clean up after their dog(s) in all areas of Trailside Dog Park. Please use the provided waste bags and receptacles within the park. Dogs are not allowed to dig inside the park. Dog owners are responsible for filling in any holes created by their dog(s).
11. Female dogs in heat are not allowed in the park. Non-neutered male dogs should be closely monitored at all times.
12. No animal or human food is allowed within Trailside Dog Park, other than small training treats.
13. Electric, metal, prong, pinch or spike collars are not allowed in the park.
14. Sick, lame or injured dogs are not allowed in the park. Dogs must be current on all vaccinations.
15. In the Small Dog Area, dogs must be less than 13" at the shoulder and weigh no more than 25 pounds.
